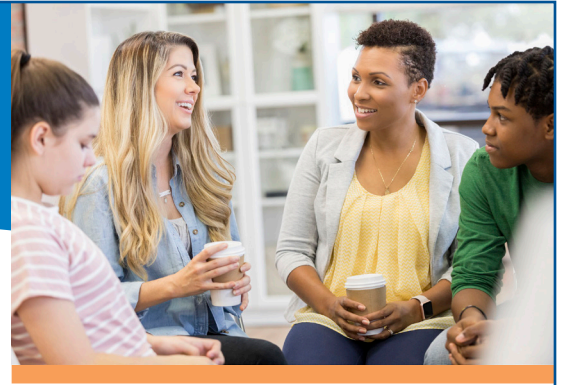


# SP<sup>3</sup> - Student Planning Pointers for Parents
